### Management Practices for Transport of Recycled Water:

- The tanker carrying recycled water must display a Coliban Water approved identification sign to allow the contents to be easily recognised by the general public and advise that the water is not suitable for drinking.
- Transport must be within a watertight and enclosed tanker.
- Recycled water cannot be stored in an airtight vessel (including a tanker) for more than 72 hours.
- The tanker and fittings used must not be contaminated with other sources of waste (e.g. septic tank effluent) that would in turn contaminate the recycled water and cause potential environmental or human health issues.



- Any tanker and fittings which have been used to transport water that is of an inferior quality to that of the recycled water must be appropriately cleaned and disinfected prior to use. The cleaning and disinfection required is to be equivalent to that required for potable (drinking) water tankers as outlined in the "Guidelines for Potable (drinking) Water Transport in Victoria" available from the Department of Human Services.
- The tanker and fittings used to transfer the recycled water to any customer onsite storage must be fitted with appropriate backflow prevention mechanisms / devices to protect against contamination or cross-connection.
- Recycled water should not be transported in tankers used for transporting potable (drinking) water for human consumption / drinking.

**General Permit Conditions:**

- Each vehicle approved will be issued with an individual swipe card. The swipe card is not transferable to any other vehicle.
- Recycled water shall only be carted to sites that are registered with Coliban Water. It is the carter's responsibility to ensure that deliveries are made to end users with current registration.
- For each vehicle, a Tanker Log Sheet shall be completed when accessing recycled water. Completed Tanker Log Sheets will be submitted to Coliban Water on a monthly basis.
- The permit holder may be subject to an inspection by Coliban Water or EPA at any time.
- The permit holder is responsible for ensuring that all vehicles are fitted out to ensure compliance with applicable OH&S standards.
- The permit holder is responsible for the recycled water in transit and will deal with any spillage or discharge of recycled water in accordance with the HEMP for Standpipe Customers.
- Coliban Water may cease the provision of recycled water at standpipes at any time, in the event that testing indicates that quality limits cannot be met or sufficient volumes are not available.
- Coliban will share the details of vehicles approved to cart recycled water with the operators / managers of potable (drinking) water standpipes to ensure that there is no cross-over between the vehicles being used to cart each supply.
- Failure to comply with the agreed management practices may result in cancellation of access to recycled water.
- Tanker disinfection records must be kept and submitted upon request.
