




Water restrictions summary

This is a summary of water restrictions on Stage 1. For full details refer to *By-Law No. 10 Water Restrictions* on our website - www.coliban.com.au

'Odds and Evens' watering rules apply:

- For odd-numbered properties, water on odd-numbered days of the month
- For even-numbered or un-numbered properties, water on even-numbered days of the month
- All properties can be watered on the 31st day of the month



-  **Odd numbered properties**
Water on Odd numbered days
-  **Even and un-numbered**
Water on Even numbered days
-  **Anyone can water on the 31st**

During this period of restriction, water supplied by Coliban Water from a water main (other than recycled water) shall be used in accordance with the following:

<p>Residential and Commercial Gardens & Lawns</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Manual sprinklers must not be used except between the hours of 6:00am and 8:00am and between the hours of 6:00pm and 8:00pm (Daylight Saving), and only then as required, and using the 'odds and evens' system. Automatic sprinklers must not be used except between the hours of midnight and 4:00am, and only then as required, and using the 'odds and evens' system. A hand-held hose or bucket can be used at any time.
<p>Public Gardens & Lawns</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Manual sprinklers must not be used except between the hours of 6:00 am and 10:00 am and between the hours of 8:00 pm and midnight, and only then as required, and using the 'odds and evens' system. Automatic sprinklers must not be used except between the hours of midnight and 8:00am, and only then as required, and using the 'odds and evens' system. A hand-held hose or bucket can be used at any time. Notwithstanding the above, a public garden may be watered in accordance with an approved Water Conservation Plan.

Vehicles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pre-rinse and rinse by hand-held hose; wash from a bucket. Use a gurney-style high-pressure washing device. Commercial car wash using a gurney-style high-pressure cleaner is OK.
Paving, concrete & other hard surfaces	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hosing banned except for construction purposes or in emergency; or for health or safety hazard.
Residential or Commercial Pools & Spas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> New pools or spas of less than 2000 litres capacity may be filled. New pools or spas of greater than 2000 litres capacity must not be filled unless a Water Conservation Plan has been submitted to Coliban Water and approved. An existing pool or spa of less than 2000 litres capacity may be filled by hand-held hose. An existing pool or spa of greater than 2000 litres capacity must not be filled unless a Water Conservation Plan has been submitted to Coliban Water and approved. An existing pool or spa must not be topped up except by means of a hand-held hose or bucket.
Pond or Lake	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A new pond or lake must not be filled from empty without written permission of Coliban Water. An existing pond or lake can be topped up by a hand-held hose (fitted with a trigger mechanism) or bucket only.
Fountains or Water Features	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must not operate unless the water recirculates and can only be topped up by bucket or hand-held hose.
Construction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hose used in construction works must be fitted with a trigger mechanism or flow shut-off device. Water may be used where safe operation of equipment requires it, or for normal testing/flushing of pipes or other works.
Dust Suppression	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Water must not be used to suppress dust, unless dust is causing a health or environmental hazard; and then only by means of either a hand-held hose, fitted with a trigger nozzle or by a watering can, filled either by a hand-held hose fitted with a trigger nozzle, or directly from a tap.
Mobile Water Tankers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A tanker must be registered with Coliban Water for the purposes of water carting, and a permit obtained. Once registered, fill anytime for in-house use, firefighting, construction, dust suppression or public health purposes. Any other intended use must be consistent with other provisions of the Bylaw.
Dams and tanks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can be refilled only for firefighting, public health or stock use, and only then with written permission of Coliban Water.
Poultry Sheds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sprinklers OK between 6 am - 9 pm, but only when the temperature inside the shed reaches 30 degrees. Use fogging systems anytime.
Sportsgrounds	<p><i>Exempt Playing Surfaces</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Manual sprinklers must not be used except on a needs basis, between the hours of 6:00am and 10:00am and between 8:00pm and midnight, according to the 'odds and evens' system. Automatic sprinklers must not be used except on a needs basis, between the hours of midnight and 8:00am, according to the 'odds and evens' system. Sportsgrounds may be watered at any time by means of a bucket or hose, fitted with a trigger mechanism or flow shut-off device. Notwithstanding the above, a sportsground may be watered in accordance with an approval Water Conservation Plan.
Commercial Market Garden or Plant Nurseries	No restrictions.
