As part of our Wimmera system upgrade works, Borung and Wychitella have recently been provided with covered water supply tanks and Korong Vale and Wedderburn with two new lined basins (4.4ML in capacity). These storages are now supplied from Grampians-Wimmera-Mallee Water's Wimmera Mallee Pipeline project.

Water restrictions outlook

The completion and final commissioning of the Wimmera Mallee Pipeline to fully supply the new raw water storage basins and tanks has been completed. Water restrictions in the Wimmera system have been reviewed and will be decreased from Stage 4 to Stage 1 from 1 July 2010.

Consumption - actual versus forecast

The graph below indicates the actual demand in the Wimmera System compared with the forecast demand for Stage 4.

Wimmera monthly actual demand for June was the same as the forecast demand. Total consumption for 2009/10 is 231ML which is 26ML less than the forecast demand.
