## Water restrictions outlook

Grampians Wimmera Mallee Water's (GMMW) storage levels continue to remain very low at only 4.4% capacity. Substantial rainfall is required before Stage 4 water restrictions in the Wimmera system can be relaxed. GMMW are progressing with the piping of the open channel system which will improve delivery and water security.
