Dam Safety Policy Statement



Coliban Water is committed to actively contributing to the safety and sustainability of our region by:

- > Adopting the approach and principles outlined in the Australian National Committee on Large Dams (ANCOLD) Guidelines on Dam Safety Management, dated August 2003;
- > Meeting the expectations and reporting requirements of the Victorian Industry Regulator the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning;
- > Maintaining appropriate dam safety management including inspection programs, maintenance, training, reporting and emergency preparation;
- > Committing to achieving recognised good practice and technology in dam safety management;
- > Managing dam safety risk in line with the ANCOLD Guidelines on Risk Assessment (2003) including prioritising dams upgrades based on life-safety and the ANCOLD Limit of Tolerability;
- > Assessing additional dam safety upgrades to lower risks based on the ANCOLD As Low As Reasonably Practical (ALARP) principle; and
- > A commitment to maintaining adequately trained staff with skills in dam safety awareness, operation and maintenance and emergency management.
